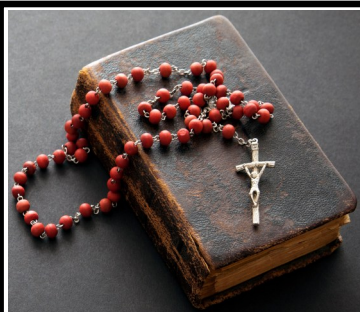

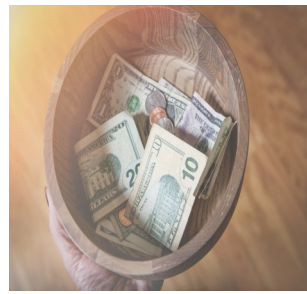

$$1 + 1 + 1 = 1$$

### Revel in the Mystery

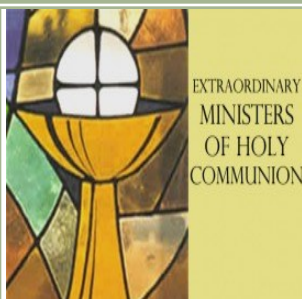
Maybe only Christians can figure out that the mystery here is the Trinity; three persons, one God. Here in the Catholic tradition, we refer to the Trinity a lot- When we begin and end prayers; when people are blessed or giving a blessing...each time we are reminding ourselves as having a Christian identity which we received in Baptism. We remind ourselves of our high calling in the lives we lead and we allow ourselves to encounter a God who dwells in mystery but who asks us, as his children, to be his hands and feet, so we proclaim him in the work we do and the reality of our journeying through life with God. We are called to be God's eyes and ears, seeing the needs around us and hearing the cry of the poor, and so on. I have had a great education, but my faith is a simple one. Right now, I am, with many, mourning the death of Msgr. Frank Moeslein. We were friends and one thing that showed his German personality was- Monsignor Frank believed in the resurrection of the body and he wanted to know how God was going to fit us all together. With my simple faith I am looking forward to God's surprise. But that didn't satisfy him and his complicated faith. Neither his faith nor mine is better than the other but they sure are different. At the end of a piece of music by Gian Carlo Menotti named *The Death of the Archbishop of Brindisi*, Menotti wrote, "Sleep, sleep in peace, O gentle pilgrim, you have not asked in vain. The eye, the tooth, the nail, each has a precise function. So why should God have given to you in life, a questioning mind, if not to hand to you in death the blinding answer? Sleep, sleep in peace. Sleep into the dawn."

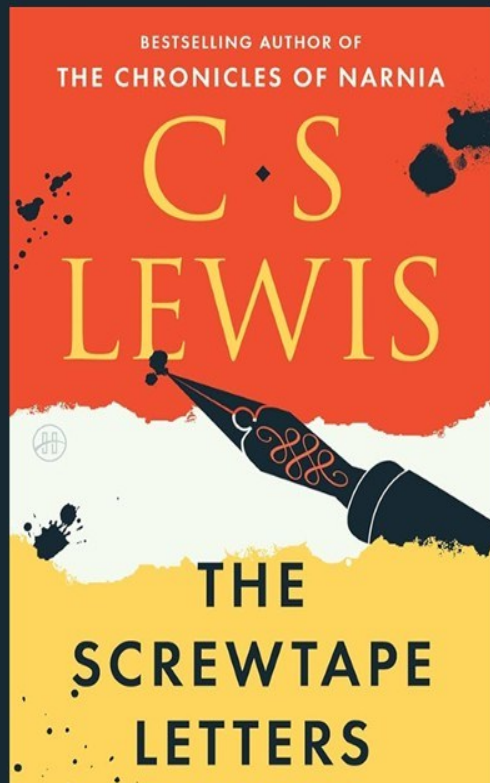

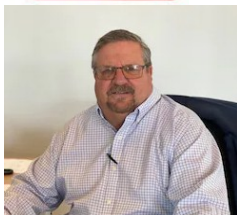

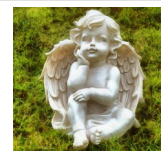
